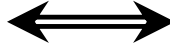

Please be advised that certification can only be obtained for documents with an **original** signature of a valid public officer. Such public officers include:

- Massachusetts Notary Public
- Justice of the Peace
- City/Town Clerk, or assistant
- Court Clerk, or assistant
- Registrar of Vital Records

Photocopied signatures of any of the above officials cannot be certified. It is important to identify which country will receive the records since different countries require different types of certification. The certification forms are basically the same; however, the name of the certificate which is attached to a document going to a country which is a signatory to the Hague Convention is known as an Apostille.
